

open Trust to apply and residue of the said interest, dividend and other income (hereinafter called the said income) and at their discretion to apply the whole or any part or parts of the corpus of the Trust Fund for such public charitable purpose including (a) relief to the Poor (b) Educational (c) Medical relief and (d) advancement of any other subject of general Public utility as per the law may be regarded as a charitable object or purpose of a Public nature as the Trustees may think fit and in such manner as the Trustees may think and for one or more of such purposes to the exclusion of other or others as the Trustees may think fit provided that the income as well as the capital shall be applied only towards public charitable purposes as aforesaid and any accumulation income shall also be made and deemed to be made for application to such public charitable purposes as aforesaid.


4. PROVIDED further that notwithstanding anything hereinbefore or hereinafter contained, the income as also the corpus of the TRUST FUND shall be applied and be applicable only to or for such public charitable purposes only and within such territories only and subject to such conditions or limitations, if any, as may from time to time be laid down in the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any replacement

re-enactment or modification thereof and further so that the TRUST hereby established shall be one to which the exemption or deductions under the provisions of the Indian Income Tax Act, 1961, or any re-enactment or modification thereof shall apply so as any donation thereto be recognized as eligible for exemption for tax in regard to the donor. That the Trustees shall obtain registration of the Trust under the Income Tax Act so that the income of the Trust may not be taxable.


5. Subject to and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing objects or Purposes, it is declared that the Trustees shall each year or from time to time, apply the residue of the income of the Trust fund and may at their discretion apply also the Trust fund or any part or parts of the trust fund in or towards any one or more of the following objects (which according to law be a public charitable object) to the exclusion of the other or others of them in such proportion and manner in all respects as the Trustees may in their absolute discretion think proper;
- a) To spread or promotion of education or learning in all its branches in such manner as the trustees may think fit including;
 - i. Establishment and/or acquisition and maintenance or support of schools, Education Vidhyapethes, study centers and other institutions for imparting education and Training of students;
 - ii. Establishment and maintenance of hostels and or boarding houses and grants of free boarding and lodging and/or grants of scholarships and/or books uniform to needy and deserving students upon such terms and for such period in each case as the Trustees may deem fit;
 - iii. Establishment and support of Professorship fellowships, lectureships, scholarships, and prizes at any schools, colleges or other educational institutions;

- b) Affording of medical relief in such manner as the Trustees may think fit including :
- i. Grant of subscriptions and donations to Hospitals, Dispensaries, and Convalescent Homes, Asylums, Nursing Homes, Orphanages, and other public Institutions for Administering medical relief to the Poor upon such terms and conditions and for Such period as the Trustees may think fit.
 - ii. Grant of medical and financial help to the Poor and grant of Medical help to any Deserving person of any community during epidemic, famine, flood or any Unforeseen calamity or war or warlike operations;
 - iii. Running of Ambulances for benefit of public at large without any discretion as to any caste, creed, religion on payment of nominal fee or at times at free of cost.
- c) Distribution of Free Food, Medical help and clothing to the Poor and Needy.
- d) Giving pecuniary allowances to poor widows, destitute, blind, dumb and crippled, disabled or aged persons.
- e) Sinking of wells and/or setting up parabola, wherever there may be necessity of water;
- f) Subscriptions, contributions, and/or donations to any public fund or institution established for promotion of public charitable Objects;
- g) Establishment, maintenance and support of library, museum and reading room for advancement or education and knowledge in general and the supply of or support to gardens and other means of public recreation for advancement of health.



Provided always also that the help to be given under any of the foregoing heads wherever the case as mentioned hereof may be given either in the way of pecuniary payments or in kind or the supply or distribution of medicines and medical relief in any manner which the Trustees may consider desirable.

- h) To maintain or establish home for the aged of both sex and maintain the aged either free of charge or on nominal payment. The aged who are not capable of earning their own lively- hood and who have no issues to maintain them shall be primarily helped financially or by granting residence, clothing, food, medical relief etc. However, those who can pay shall pay for their expenses.
- i) For the spiritual and moral upliftment of the Society to arrange theosophical discourses to establish better understanding of one religion for the entire human race and to remove difference amongst human beings on the basis of different religions and impart knowledge and education in spiritual life.
- j) To help and/or establish Panjapol for the protection of animals and birds.
- k) To contribute towards Improvement of cattle breeding.

6. The Public charity hereby established shall always be named and called 'MANAKCHAND PRABHUDAN CHARITABLE TRUST,' Lohiya marg, Kamptee-441002.





purposes according to law, then in that case the Trustees shall apply and expend the said income or corpus towards the execution and carrying out of such of the objects and purposes aforesaid as may be public charitable objects or purposes or such other objects or purposes of a public charitable nature as the Trustees may think fit subject nevertheless to the directions or limitations contained in clauses 3 and 4.

8. The surplus and unapplied portion of the amount, if any, arising in any one or more year or years the trustees shall be investing the same and the resulting. Income thereof from time to time in any of the investments in which the trust fund are hereby directed or authorized to be invested and may be credited to an account to be called " The surplus Account" and the said trustees shall have power in any subsequent year or years to expend or apply the same in the same manner and to the same extent as if such accumulation or parts thereof had been part of the income of the year or years in which the same are or is sought to be expended and applied as aforesaid.

11. (1) **Shri Rajendra Rambabu Agarwal** , and (2) **Shri Gajendra Rambabu Agarwal** are jointly and severally appointed as the first Managing Trustees and the Trustees for the time being of these presents may appoint additional Managing Trustee or the Trustees from among them with all or such of the powers and





- e) To appoint and dismiss and re - appoint, employee, servant, clerks, caretakers and others on such salary and on such terms as they think fit.
- f) To delegate by power of attorney or otherwise to any Trustee or other Persons whomsoever any power implied by law or confirmed by statute or vested in the trustees by these presents but the trustees shall not be held liable or responsible for the acts or defaults of any such persons or person but only for their own respective acts and defaults.



- g) To accept donations of money and/or any property movable or Immovable on such terms and conditions as the Trustees may think fit not being inconsistent with these presents or the Trust hereby established and the Trustees may accept condition that such donations or any part thereof may be expressed and applied in the name of the donor or any other name which the donor may indicate. No donation, however, will be accepted with conditions requiring change in the name of the charity referred to in clause 6.
- h) To appoint any person or persons to fill any vacancy or vacancies of the Office of Trustees of these presents or as an additional Trustees or Trustee.
- i) To decide all question arising in the administration of trusts hereby and including all questing relating to the interpretation of these presents or otherwise concerning or touching these presents or any clause or thing herein contained or touching or concerning anything matter relating to connected with or arising out of these presents of the operation thereof.-The decision of the Trustees on all of any of the matters aforesaid shall be final.
- j) To grant leases for such period and on such rent and terms and conditions (including an option to the lessee to Purchase) as they may think fit to accept surrender of any lease and it is hereby declared that any premium or fine shall be treated as Income or as capital or partly as Income and partly as capital as the Trustees may think fit.
12. a) The Trustees may meet together for transacting of the business, adjourn and otherwise regulate their meetings and proceedings, as they may think fit.
- b) A resolution passed by circulation without any meeting of the Trustees a And evidenced by writing under the hands or the majorities of The Trustees shall be

14. If the trustees hereby constituted or any of them or the trustees or trustee Appointed as herein provided shall die or express the desire to be discharged or refuses appointment or is convicted of criminal offence involving moral turpitude and punished with imprisonment exceeding six months or be absent from India for a period of twelve months or more without obtaining leave of the other trustees in writing or absconding for a period of three or more months without intimating his whereabouts, then the surviving or continuing trustees or trustee for the time being may subject to the provision of the clause 18(h) and 17 thereof by a writing appoint any person or persons in the place of trustee or trustees so dying, desiring to be discharged or refusing to accept becoming incapable to act or adjudicated insolvent or convicted of a criminal offence with appraisement as aforesaid or being absent from India as aforesaid or absconding.

15. a) The number of the Trustee shall at no time be less than 2 (TWO) nor more than 10(TEN)

b) On every appointment of Trustee, the trust fund shall if and so far As the nature of the property and other circumstances shall Require or admit and unless the Trustees otherwise resolve but So as not to prejudice the powers of the Managing trustee be Transferred so that the same may be vested in the Trustees or Trustee for the time being each and every trustee so appointed As aforesaid may as well before as after such transfer act or Assist in the execution of the Trusts and Powers of these Presents and fully and effectual as if he had been hereby Constituted as Trustee.

16. The Trustees shall be respectively chargeable only for such moneystocks Funds securities and other funds or the Trusts property as they shall respectively actually receive notwithstanding their signing any receipt for the same or conformity and

and not for those of others nor for those of any bankers, brokers or other persons in whose hands any trust moneys or securities may be placed nor or any deficiency of the stocks, funds or security nor otherwise for any involuntary losses unless the same shall happen due or through their own willful defaults.

17. The trustees may establish dispensary, hospital in order to render services to the public at reasonable rate and may appoint for the purpose qualified staff and income earned shall be the income of the Trust.
18. The trustees may also render services by way of legal aid to the needy litigant Public in any matter including taxation matters and the Trustees may appoint qualified persons on remuneration and may establish office, with furniture etc. Any income from this legal profession earned shall be the Income of the Trust.
19. The trustees may establish library for the benefit of the Public at large and can spend necessary amount over it from the trust fund.
20. For the proper administration the trustees may authorize one of them to manage the whole affairs and devote substantial time and attention and such trustee who may accept such appointment, may be paid reasonable The Trustees may mutually decide remuneration and such trustee may also be given residential facility, residential telephone, and Conveyance facilities. The trustees by mutual consent and by proper Resolution may increase objects of the trust and may find out the resources to increase income of the trust.
21. Due to unforeseen circumstances or due to any kind of legislation or due to Inability of the trustee to manage the trust the Trustees may distribute the Trust funds to other trust having similar objects and finally dissolve the Trust.



After examining the proposal, The Maharashtra Pollution Control Board hereby Renew Combined Consent and BMW Authorization to HCF under Section 25/26 of the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974, Section 21 of the Air (P&CP) Act, 1981 and Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016, and Authorization under Rule 5 of the Hazardous Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 respectively, under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, subject to terms and conditions as specified below and in the Schedules(I-IV) and Annexures (I-II) enclosed in this order.

1. This CCA shall be in force for a period from 01-12-2021 To 30-11-2025
2. The capital investment of the HCF is ₹1212.92 Lakhs (As per C.A Certificate Submitted by HCF)
3. HCF Area: - Plot Area 4185.00 M² with Built-up area 1860.00 M².

5. Conditions under the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974:-

1. Quantity of total water consumption shall not exceed 114.80 M³/day. You shall not use the ground water without obtaining prior permission of Central Ground Water Authority.
2. You shall provide adequate treatment & disposal facility for Sewage & Effluent generated as specified in Annexure-I
3. You shall provide water meter at water intake point & at sewage/Effluent disposal point and shall maintain monthly records thereof.

6. Conditions under the Air (P&CP) Act,1981:-

1. You shall use the fuel for DG set as specified in the Annexure-II.
2. You shall provide adequate emission control system to DG set as specified in Annexure-II.
3. You shall strictly observe noise standards applicable for DG set stack emission and ambient noise level as per Annexure-II.

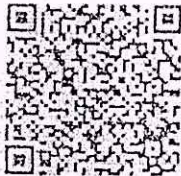

 3. **Cytotoxic Drugs/ Waste:** You shall have separate storage, marked with the symbol of Bio Hazard & Cytotoxic Hazard for outdated, discarded, unused cytotoxic drugs/waste and submit details of Management and Handling of outdated, discarded, unused Cytotoxic drugs in the format prescribed by CPCB which is available on www.cpcb.nic.in along with Annual Report to MPCB with a copy to CPCB before 30th June of every year.
 4. **Mercury Waste:** You shall manage the Mercury Waste in HCE in environmentally sound manner (including storage, spilled collection, transportation and disposal) as per guidelines published by CPCB as detailed in document entitled "Environmentally Sound Management of Mercury Waste in Health Care Facilities" (www.cpcb.nic.in).

2. You shall establish bar code for handling of bio-medical waste.
3. You shall ensure segregation of Bio-Medical Waste in colour coded bags as per BMW Management Rules, 2016
4. You shall not store Bio Medical waste beyond 48 hours from the generation.
5. You shall use only non-chlorinated plastic coloured bags.
6. You shall ensure use of colour coded bins and bags for segregation of BMW as required under BMW Management Rules 2016.
7. You shall not mix General/other Solid waste with Bio Medical Waste.
8. You shall ensure segregation, treatment and disposal of General / Other Municipal solid waste as per Solid Waste Management rules, 2016.
9. You shall pay the charges to authorized Common Bio Medical waste Treatment and Disposal facility for its services as agreed upon during the membership registration or as amended.
10. You shall comply and strictly abide with the conditions stipulated in BMW Management Rules, 2016 as amended time to time.
11. You shall handover Plastic / Metal waste (BMW) to Common Bio medical waste treatment and Disposal facility allocated to you for treatment & disposal or plastic/metal recycler authorized by MPCB for BMW Handling and maintain records thereof & submit to MPCB in Annual report.
12. You shall provide training to all workers involved in handling of bio-medical waste at the time of induction and at least once a year thereafter and maintain record thereof.
13. You shall undertake appropriate medical examination of all BMW Waste handlers & staff at the time of induction and at least once in a year and immunize all involved in management of Bio Medical Waste for protection against diseases, including Hepatitis B and Tetanus, that are likely to be transmitted while handling bio medical waste and maintain the records for the same.
14. You shall ensure use of personal protective Equipment such as Heavy Duty Gloves (Workman's Gloves), Gum Boots or safety shoes for waste collectors, Face mask, Head Cap, Splash Proof Gowns or aprons etc., Disposal gloves by waste handlers.
15. You shall develop and operate own website. The website should be uploaded on monthly basis with all the information relating to Bio-Medical waste management including this CCA and other permission and report.
16. You shall maintain all record for Generation, for a period of five years and produce whenever asked by MPCB authorities.
17. The occupier and operator of a Health Care Establishment shall be liable for all the damages caused to the environment or the public due to improper handling of bio-medical wastes.
18. You shall ensure submission of Annual Report of BMW for the period Jan to Dec, including category and quantity of BMW Generated and Disposed in Form IV for preceding year before 30th June of every year to the Regional Office, MPCB, Nagpur and uploading the same to MPCB Portal (<https://www.ecmpcb.in/>).

The following general conditions shall apply:-


1. You shall provide facility for collection of environmental samples and samples of trade and sewage effluents, air emissions and hazardous waste to the Board staff at the terminal or designated points and shall pay to the Board for the services rendered in this behalf.
2. Whenever due to any accident or other unforeseen act or event, such emissions occur or is apprehended to occur in excess of standards laid down, such information shall be forthwith reported to Board, concerned Police Station, Executive Engineer MIDC and Local Body. In case of failure of pollution control equipment's, the process connected to it shall be stopped.
3. You shall provide an alternate electric power source sufficient to operate all pollution control facilities installed to maintain compliance with the terms and conditions of the consent. In the absence, the applicant shall stop, reduce or otherwise, control operation to abide by terms and conditions of this consent.
4. You shall submit to this office, the 30th day of September every year, the Environmental Statement Report for the financial year ending 31st March in the prescribed Form-V as per the provisions of rule 15 of the Environment (Protection) (Second Amendment) Rules, 1992.
5. You shall comply with the Hazardous Waste (M, H & TM) Rules, 2016 and submit the Annual Returns as per Rule 20(2) of Hazardous Waste (M, H & TM) Rules, 2016 for the preceding year April to March in Form-IV by 30th June of every year to Regional Office, Nagpur.
6. You shall engage qualified staff/personnel/agency to see the day to day compliance of consent & authorization condition towards Environment Protection.
7. Separate drainage system shall be provided for collection of trade and sewage effluents. Terminal manholes shall be provided at the end of the collection system with arrangement for measuring the flow. No effluent shall be admitted in the pipes/sewers downstream of the Terminal manholes. No effluent shall find its way other than in designed and provided collection system.
8. Neither storm water nor discharge from other premises shall be allowed to mix with the effluents from the HCE.
9. You shall install a separate meter showing the consumption of energy for operation of domestic and industrial effluent treatment plants and air pollution control system. A register showing consumption of chemicals used for treatment shall be maintained.
10. You should not cause any nuisance in surrounding area. You shall maintain good housekeeping.
11. You shall bring minimum 33% of the available open land under green coverage/ plantation. The applicant shall submit a yearly statement by 30th September every year on available open plot area, number of trees surviving as on 31st March of the year and number of trees planted.
12. The non-hazardous solid waste arising in the HCE premises, sweepings, etc. be disposed of scientifically so as not to cause any nuisance / pollution. The applicant shall take necessary permissions from civic authorities for disposal of solid waste.
13. You shall achieve the National Ambient Air Quality standards prescribed vide Government of India, Notification Dated. 16/11/2009 as amended.
